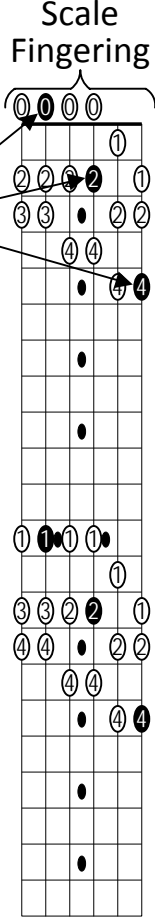
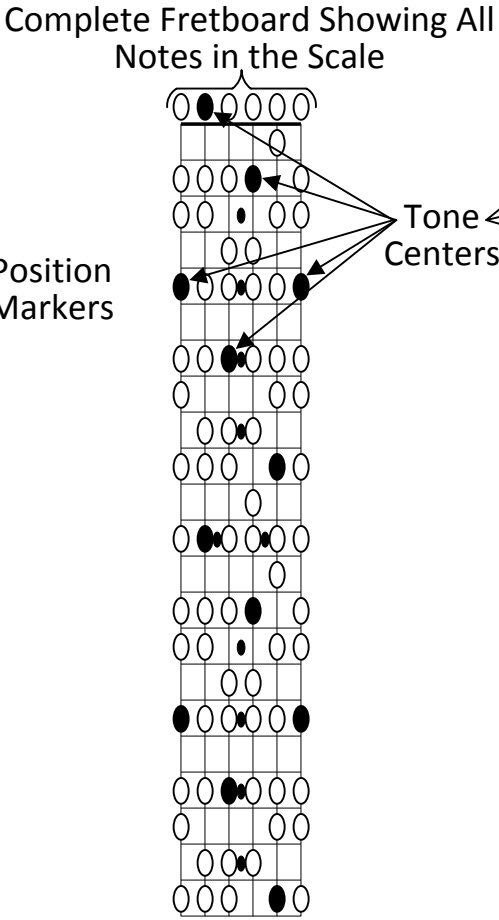
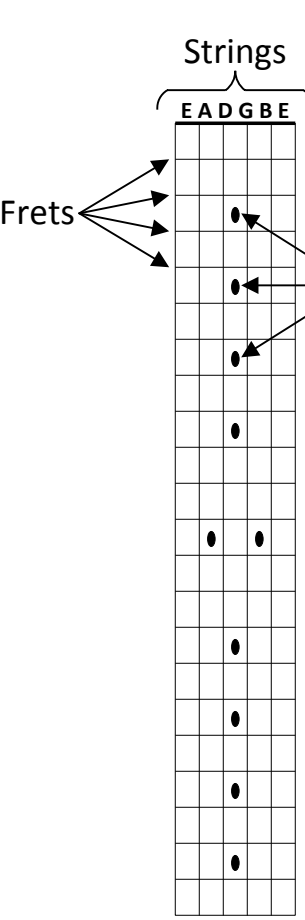


# How to read Fretboard Diagrams

Scale Key: **A**  
 Scale Name: **Dorian**

Scale Notes	→	<b>A</b>	<b>B</b>	<b>C</b>	<b>D</b>	<b>E</b>	<b>F#</b>	<b>G</b>
Scale Formula	→	<b>1</b>	<b>2</b>	<b>b3</b>	<b>4</b>	<b>5</b>	<b>6</b>	<b>b7</b>



- ⓪ -Open Tone Center
- ① -1st.Finger Tone Center
- ② -2nd.Finger Tone Center
- ③ -3rd.Finger Tone Center
- ④ -4th.Finger Tone Center
- ⓪ -Open note
- ① -1st.Finger note
- ② -2nd.Finger note
- ③ -3rd.Finger note
- ④ -4th.Finger note

1. Press 1st.Finger on 5th.Fret E String and Pick.
2. Press 3rd.Finger on 7th.Fret E String and Pick.
3. Press 4th.Finger on 8th.Fret E String and Pick.
4. Continue on to the A,D,G,B and High E String in the same manner, then descend back to the Low E String.
